

The John C. Heerspink Scholarship Application

The Western Michigan Planned Giving Group (WMPGG) announces the creation of the John C. Heerspink Scholarship. This scholarship honors John Heerspink who faithfully served the profession for many years in West Michigan.

The John C. Heerspink Scholarship is granted annually to a deserving recipient. The scholarship provides the registration fee and lodging and meal costs at the national CGP Conference, hosted by the National Association of Charitable Gift Planners. The per diem meal allowance is a maximum of \$50 and will be reimbursed once detailed receipts are submitted to the WMPGG Board Treasurer. There is no reimbursement for alcohol purchases.

Criteria for Application Eligibility:

- WMPGG membership for a minimum of two years.
- Ability to cover round trip travel expenses through the applicant's organization or from personal funds.
- Preference will be given to applicants who have never attended a CGP Conference.
- Preference will be given to applicants who are fund raising staff members of non-profit organizations. Allied professionals may apply.
- The scholarship recipient agrees to make a brief presentation at the following year's WMPGG Annual Business meeting sharing the value of attending the CGP Conference and a concept learned at the conference that they have implemented in the organization they serve.
